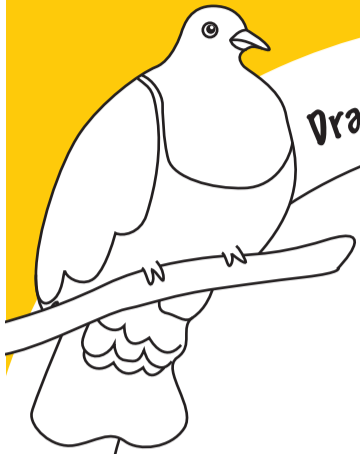
# ART COMPETITION TIME!
